CELEBRATION GOLF CLUB AGAIN EARNS 4-1/2 STAR RATING IN GOLF DIGEST "BEST PLACES TO PLAY."

Celebration, FL-Celebration Golf Club repeated its 4-1/2 star rating in the *Golf Digest* "Best Places to Play" 2006-2007 edition just published. The club earned the same rating in the 2004-2005 edition. Celebration also received special recognition for both "Standard of Service" and "Pace of Play."

The guidebook includes ratings made by about 20,000 *Golf Digest* readers of more than 3,500 public-access golf courses in the United States, Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean. The ratings are on a scale of one to five based upon "overall golf experience, value for the money, standard of service at the facility, overall conditioning of the course, and normal pace of play."

Of the 1700-plus golf courses in Florida, only 45 received the 4-1/2 star rating, the highest in the state. According to *Golf Digest*, the rating places a course between "Outstanding" and "Superb," indicating "Golf at it's best."

"Obviously, we are honored and privileged to again be recognized as one of the top courses in the country," said Celebration Golf Club general manager, Gene Garrote. He added, "What is especially gratifying is that the ratings come from the opinions of those who have played the course. Having received the 4-1/2 stars over an extended period of time proves the consistent high level of service and facilities the Celebration staff takes great pride in delivering."

"To be recognized as one of the top all around golf courses in the country really does require a total team effort. But, it starts with Larry Snyder, a Certified Golf Course Superintendent, and his crew who work hard to maintain the best possible playing conditions year around, even after recovering from hurricanes."

The course opened in 1996 and was designed by the world-renowned father/son team of Robert Trent Jones and Robert Trent Jones, Jr. The exquisitely crafted par-72 championship

layout winds its way through scenic natural wetlands and serves as the centerpiece of the quaint master planned community of Celebration. Five sets of tees, ranging in length from 2,166 yards at the beginner tees to 6,786 yards from the championship tees, provide players at all skill levels with a fun and challenging test of golf. The course's extensive facilities include a beautiful 10,500-square-foot clubhouse with high-end Pro Shop; locker rooms; full service restaurant and private banquet room; a two-sided aquatic driving range; a unique three-hole course for juniors only and an Award Winning Golf Academy.

Each year Celebration Golf Club hosts nearly 300 organized golf events and has become nationally known for its Red Carpet Tournament Services. Past tournaments have included the Buick Scramble National Championships, the USGA Senior Open and USGA Senior Amateur Qualifiers, the Florida State Public Links Championship and the Florida Amateur Championships. In March 2004, PGA Tour player Robert Gamez hosted his first celebrity Pro-Am tournament at Celebration, which has been the permanent home for the event since then.

Celebration Golf Club is owned and operated by CS Golf Partners, LLC, which owns or manages six golf courses in Florida and Canada.
