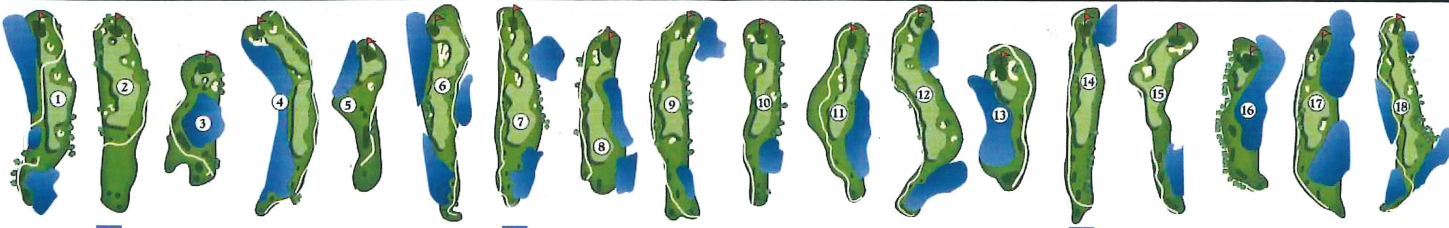

LOCAL RULES OF PLAY

1. USGA Rules govern all play, except where local rules apply.
2. Play is restricted from all Environmentally Protected Areas.
3. Please avoid wildlife on golf course.
4. White picket fences along holes 2, 7 and 12 are designated as out-of-bounds.
5. The inside edge of pedestrian sidewalks along holes 1, 3, 4, 5 and 18 are designated as out-of-bounds.
6. Any ball hit off of golf course property is considered out-of-bounds.
7. On hole 6 (left lake) any ball coming to rest on the left side of the lake above the water's edge is considered out-of-bounds. The white picket fence behind green is also considered out-of-bounds.

RULES OF ETIQUETTE

1. Non-metal spikes required.
2. Repair ball marks on greens. Fill all divots with mix. Rake all sand bunkers.
3. Carts are to remain on paths at all times near or around all tees and greens.
4. Each group is expected to complete play within the 4 hour 30 minute time limit, or may be asked to suspend play. Please keep up with the group in front of you at all times.
5. Proper golf attire is required at all times.



The law provides that injury and/or damage caused by the golfer on the course is the responsibility of the golfer. Golf course is irrigated with reclaimed water.



Restrooms are located on holes 3, 8, and 13 and at the Clubhouse

RANGE RULES

1. Practice from the designated range tee areas only.
2. Please do not hit range balls outside or beyond the water areas.

COURSE YARDAGE MARKERS: Markers are located on cart paths, on sprinkler heads and in the center of fairways. All yardages are to the center of the green.

HAZARDS

All Water Hazards are defined by a red stake and/or line and are played as a Lateral Hazard.

Out-of-Bounds is defined by white stake.

Environmentally Protected Areas are designated with green caps placed on top of markers.
